

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

### **Can I pay my fees by cash or check?**

Cash or checks are no longer accepted for payments - there are no extra processing or credit card fees charged.

### **Can I pay all of my fees at once?**

Fees can be paid in full during time of online registration,

### **How do I pay my fees in installments?**

In order to choose multiple payment option, continue to the payment screen in registration where you will enter a credit card (at the end) and you will be presented with the option to pay in installments.

If you elect to use the payment plan option rather than pay in full, PickleJuice will securely store your credit/debit card and automatically charge you for the appropriate fee portion on the above dates. The exact amounts charged each month will be shown during the registration process and you will receive an email reminder 3 days before the payment is charged to your card.

### **What should I do if I can't pay my installments on the due dates?**

If you need to work out an alternate plan, reach out to the Band Director and Treasurer at [treasurer@cambridgeband.org](mailto:treasurer@cambridgeband.org). You must still complete the registration process online using the link above, choose the "payment plan option", and pay the \$100 deposit to ensure the student is registered with the band program before we will be able to extend the payment plan structure.

### **What are the required uniform items I need to purchase for my student?**

**ALL NEW MARCHING BAND MEMBERS must purchase under uniform shirt, shorts, and shoes.** Members will wear the the under uniform shirt and shorts under their marching band uniform. RETURNING MEMBERS may elect to purchase these if needed.

### **How do I know what medical forms I need to submit?**

The following forms are required for ALL students:

- Physical
- Emergency Medical Form

- SHS-1 Medicine Authorization

If your child needs to carry an EpiPen or prescription medication, you will need to upload the SHS-2 (Authorization to Carry Medicine)
